♥ Barbara Ingram School welcomes **Two New Art Majors** from Washington County Technical High school, Computer Game Development & Animation and Digital Communications, whose classes will be offered in the newly-renovated **Vincent Rauth Groh Academic Center**.

♥ The **Senior Lamp Post Project** celebrated the graduating Class of 2020 with individual signs hanging on their own lamp post near the square.

♥ Instrumentalist Stephanie Vicarte developed the **BISFA Robotics Club** this academic year.

♥ **Creative Writing** -- Opened the pages of their Annual Encyclopedia and Senior Readings to a virtual audience.

♥ **Dance** -- "Broke it down" at two hip-hop master classes in New York City, including with members of the cast of Broadway's Mean Girls musical.
